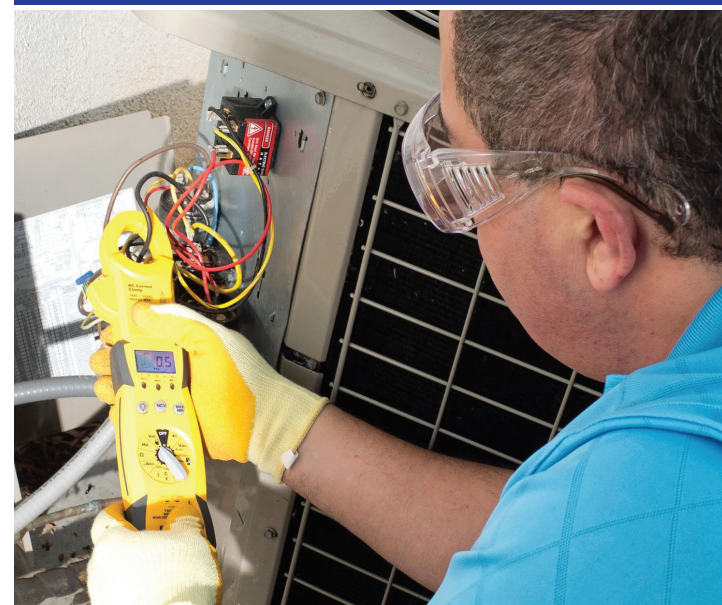

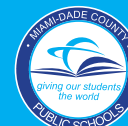

➤ Introduction

The Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, and Heating Technology program provides students with the technical knowledge and skills needed for employment in the industry. Instruction includes a combination of classroom theory and practical experiences. Some of the topics covered in the program include tools, equipment, brazing, basic electricity, compressors, troubleshooting, and installation of a basic system. A vocational certificate is issued upon successful completion of this 1,350-hour program.

Employment in the air conditioning, refrigeration, and heating field is projected to increase 14% from 2014 to 2024, much faster than the average occupations.

Upon obtaining a state vocational certificate and continued training, placement opportunities in a professional position in the air conditioning, refrigeration and heating field is enhanced.

➤ Salary

The average wage for Air Conditioning Mechanics is \$19.31 hourly, or \$40,160 annually.
