7 Introduction

The Phlebotomy program prepares individuals, under the supervision of health care professionals, to draw blood samples from patients using a variety of procedures. Phlebotomists draw blood for tests, transfusions, research, or blood donations. Some explain their work to patients and provide assistance when patients have questions/concerns after their blood is drawn. The Phlebotomy program includes 165 hours.

Employment Opportunities

Phlebotomy technicians are primarily stationed in doctor's office or hospitals, and will routinely work directly with patients and families.

Employment of phlebotomists is projected to grow 25% through 2024, much faster than the average for all occupations. Hospitals, diagnostic laboratories, blood donor centers, and other locations will need phlebotomists to perform bloodwork.
