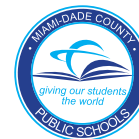

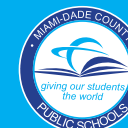

➤ Introduction

Today, automotive technicians use computers and scanners to help diagnose problems in cars. Our high tech automotive service technology program provides for 10 occupational points of 1,800 hours of training in areas of automotive specialization. ➤ Employment Opportunities

Automotive technicians can work for a dealership, an independent shop, or open their own shop. Dealership level opportunities are available for shop foremen, service advisors, or service managers.

➤ Employment Outlook

Employment in the automotive industry is expected to grow 5 percent from 2014 to 2024, about as fast as the average for all occupations.

➤ Salary

The average hourly wage and salary earnings for automotive service technicians and mechanics, including commission are \$18.60 per hour, or \$38,690 annually.
